## Legislative Interviews

- Opportunity to get updated information from lawmakers on advocacy priorities
- For legislator to hear what priority issues we have
- Establish a relationship between the League, local constituents, and the legislator
- Timeline: January-end of March

## Advocacy Calls

- To contribute to the policy expertise of our lobby corps and League members
- Prepare LC members to educate others, attend events, possibly lobby & testify themselves

## Policy Committees

- Help craft the legislative priorities of the League
- Track legislation, prepare and recommend action, educate
- Goal to develop more policy experts that can participate in legislative meetings on specific issue areas.
